



Thank you for your purchase! Your <u>A3GMunitions.com</u> Case Feed Stop has a limited lifetime warranty. We will repair or replace the Case Feed Stop if breakage occurs during normal use by the original purchaser for the life of the product. Any warranty claim must begin by securing an RMA from us, via email, for return of the broken/defective product. Return shipping is the responsibility of the buyer however we will cover shipping of the new unit.

Dillon 1050 Case Feed Stop Instructions

These instructions will guide you through installing your <u>A3GMunitions.com</u> Case Feed Stop for the Dillon RL1050 and Super1050.

1. To Install place your left index finger on the front of the Case Feed Plunger.



2. Push the Casefeed plunger into the frame. If there is a case in the Shellplate at this position use your other hand to remove it before pressing the Plunger all the way in. You should be able to easily remove the case when the Plunger is just over halfway into the frame.



3. Place the hole in the Case Feed Stop over the Casefeed Plunger Bolt and snap the square side over the frame of the press.



5. To store the Case Feed Stop when not in use simply snap the round part on the Casefeed Tube.





4. To remove the Case Feed Stop pull the press handle all the way down and unsnap the round end of the Case Feed Stop from the frame gently allowing the Case Feed Plunger to extend until the Casefeed Roller hits the Casefeed Cam. Please note, you can remove the Case Feed Stop without lowering the toolhead however if a case is moved into the shell plate the next pull of the handle will cause that case to be drawn back into the frame and the case will likely be bent or damaged by the case waiting in the bottom of the Casefeed Tube.

When the Case Feed Stop is installed for the first time you may hear a light cracking noise. This is nothing to be concerned about it is simply the plastic releasing some of the tension from the creation process.
